Pupils' Questionnaire

During the year pupils completed a number of questionnaires, both departmental and whole school questionnaires. The purpose of these questionnaires was to identify positive issues and aspects that the school need to address. See below for some of the whole school survey questions completed in Spring; thanks to the 220 pupils who responded to them!

96% felt safe in school.

92% felt they were doing well in school.

93% felt that teachers were helping them to learn and progress, and helping them when they had problems.

97% felt they were encouraged to do things for themselves and to take responsibility.

94% felt that the school was helping them to understand and respect people from other backgrounds.

Thanks to the 44 parents who completed a questionnaire in January. We have acted on the aspects highlighted, and will continue to act on them during the academic year 2016-2017.

On 1st July, 175 pupils (a cross-section of years 7 to 12) completed a questionnaire with a specific focus on Teaching and Learning standards; these are the main findings of that questionnaire:

96% felt that teaching standards had improved considerably.

90% felt that teachers were including various learning strategies in their lessons.

93% felt that the work set by teachers challenged them.

88% felt that teachers' marking helped them to improve the standard of their work.

92% felt that teachers' marking in school was consistent, i.e. regular marking, 2 stars marking at the end of an extended task, SPLAT.

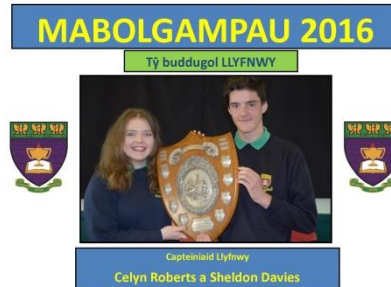

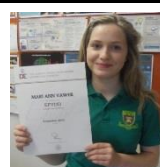
