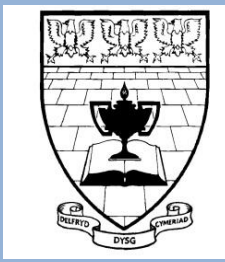

School Reward Scheme



Following discussion with the school council, parents and school staff, it became clear that everyone was keen to establish a reward scheme to praise pupils' good work and efforts. The reward scheme has now been designed, and the school council, governors and all pupils have been given a presentation to explain it. As part of the reward scheme, there will be an element of competition among pupils to collect stickers for work and effort in lessons. Pupils will then be able to 'spend' the stickers in the 'shop', where many different items will be available, including small prizes like pens, highlighters etc. or save their stickers to buy one of the main rewards, including a football or rugby ball and vouchers to spend in shops or on iTunes. The reward scheme will begin at the start of the summer term and we look forward to measuring its impact and success.
